Questions about Nest

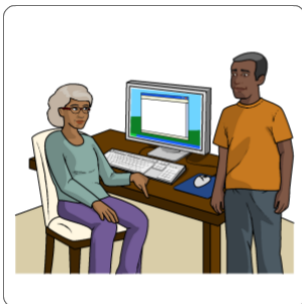
What is Nest?



Nest is a website.



Nest can help you find a place to live.



Nest is easy to use. You can ask a carer or friend to help you look at it.

You can find Nest at www.gonest.com.au

Do I have to sign up?



No. If you do not sign up, you can still search for a place to live.

You will get better information if you do sign up.

What information will I need to give?

When you sign up, you will give information like:



Where you would like to live



What kind of place you would like to live in.

For example:

- A house
- An apartment
- A villa
- A group home



What you want to have in your home.

For example:

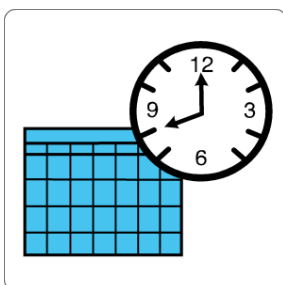
- A garden
- Ramp access
- A private laundry
- A ceiling hoist



What kind of funding or support you have.

For example:

- NDIS funding
- Disability Service Pension
- Nation Rental Affordability Scheme funding
- Private or own funding



When you would like to move in

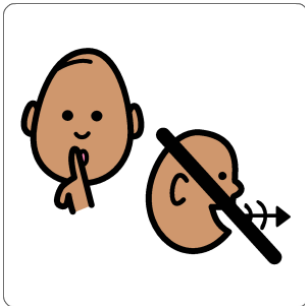
What if I don't want to live in NSW?



Right now, you can find places in NSW, ACT and SA.

Soon, you can find places all over Australia.

Will my information be shared?



Nest will not give your information to anyone else.

Questions about signing up to Nest

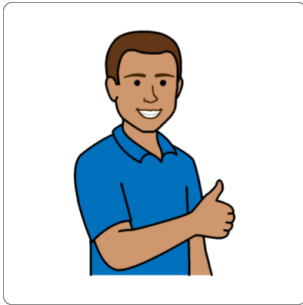
Where can I find the information I need to sign up?



If you have NDIS funding, you can find most of the information you need on your NDIS plan.

If you are using other types of funding, you will need to have that information ready when you sign up.

Why does Nest need all this information?

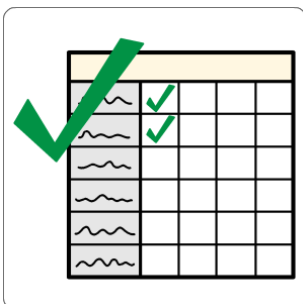


So that it can find the best place for you to live.

Do I have to answer all the questions?



No. You only need to answer the questions with an asterisk (*) next to them.



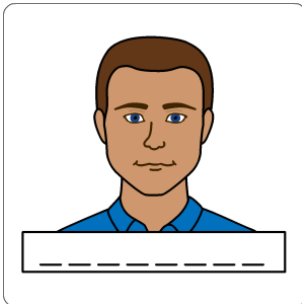
You should try to answer all the questions you can.

If you answer all the questions, you will get a better match.

What information does Nest give to providers?

Providers will get your information after you ask to move in to one of their spots.

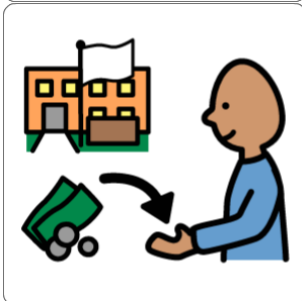
The provider will get:



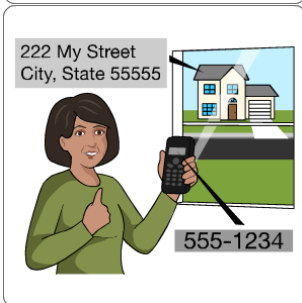
- Your name



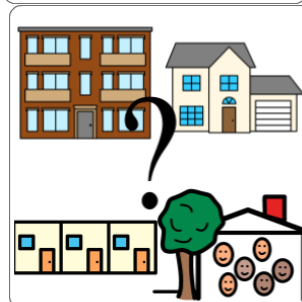
- Where you want to live



- What funding you have



- How to contact you



- What type of place you are looking for

Questions about matching and applying for a spot

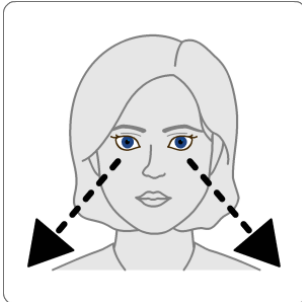
How does matching work?



When you do a search, Nest will give you a list of places to look at.

Nest will try to show you places that have what you want.

The list will show the best place for you at the top.



The places further down on the list could still be good for you, so look at them all.

I have found a home that I like. What do I do?

If you like a place and it has a free spot, you can send an application.



Your details will be given to the provider

The provider will contact you.



You might not be offered a spot.

If you are offered a spot, you do not have to move in.

Will all the places on the list take my application?

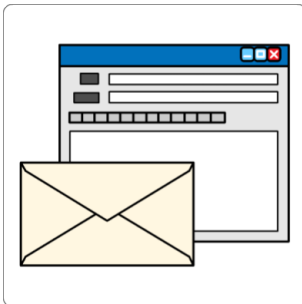


Probably not. Places will show up on your list, even if they are full.

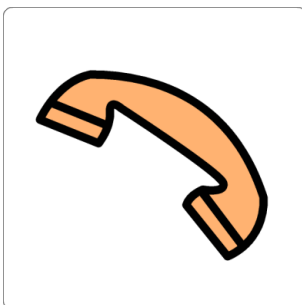


If a place that you like is not taking applications, you can save it and check again later.
